


Set Up Your Leak Alerts



Welcome to your water use dashboard

Once you log in you'll find yourself here.


The At a Glance section is a quick read of your water use patterns.

Below it, you can toggle between different graph views - hour, day, month, year. You can Print/Download your graph, or Export Data as a spreadsheet.


Click "More Options" to add precipitation or temperature data to your graph, to optimize your irrigation with rainfall.

In the *Your Meter* section, review how often you're collecting data, and see when your last data was downloaded to your account.


The final and most important task is to set up your leak alert system. Click the *Set Leak Alert* button and follow the next 4 steps.




Select your use pattern - if you have an ice maker fridge or 24/7 drip irrigation, then your use is continuous. If your expect water use to go to zero between uses, then intermittent is for you.



You know your usage better than anyone else, so you can guess what kind of output would look like trouble. Incase you aren't quite yet familiar with it, a good setting to start with is between 2-5 gallons/hr. You can always come back and change this, and all the settings, as you get more familiar with your norms.



You can set your alerts to be delivered via email or text message. Enter your email and press the plus button. If you'd like to enter your phone number, you'll do so in SMS gateway format. For more on formatting, click the i button.



Be sure your alert is set to active or inactive, depending on your preference, and get acquainted with the different alerts you'll receive for various steps in the problem's resolution cycle.
